


### Lesson 3 – Starting Your First Page Basic Page Layout

After this lesson you should be able to use CSS style sheet to:

1. apply basic text formatting (font size, font style, bold, underline and font color)
2. organize the text in the property: border
3. Applying CLASS and ID in HTML file
4. modifying CSS properties in Macromedia Dreamweaver

1. Create a CSS file by typing the style sheet as below:


